- **2. Review and approve minutes- Natalie** Ashley Alder motioned to approve the minutes and Nyla Weaver seconded. The vote was unanimous to approve.
- 3. Principal's Report on school items
 - a) Survey Results-Amendment info Mr. King shared with us the Survey Results. Results were mixed, but a number of teachers asked for the money to be spent to help the Kindergarten classes with an aide. Ashley proposed that we vote for Option B, Mr. Jones seconded. The vote was unanimous to approve Option B. Option B was to spend 10.224.0 for kindergarten (it will be less depending on how long it takes us to hire the TAs.) And then use the remaining money for technology.
 - b) Extended Day Kindergarten data
 - 30 students were invited, 20 attended.
 - 88% attendance was achieved
 - Writing Lower Case went from 44% to 69%, Writing Upper Case went from 58% to 83% and Identifying sounds went from 61.5% to 92%
 - c) The new tables from the playground should be here on January 22nd. Also the school will get a new boiler, chiller and controls this calendar year. They will either start in the spring, and finish in the summer or start in the summer and finish in the fall.
 - d) Reviewed the new school report card. We are a Typical School, but very close to a Developing School. The school has committees that are working on different areas in order to improve in these areas.
