 - **a.** Mr. King and Mrs. Pendergast analyzed data and concluded that as a school Language Arts needs improvement in comprehension and vocabulary. As a school overall math needs improvement in math facts.
 - **b.** We plan to measure growth throughout the year to evaluate progress toward goals. Arts can be measured by SRI and math can be measured by testing math facts.
 - **c.** This year SAGE in Language Arts: 43% proficient and 43 MGP (medium growth percentile). This year SAGE in Math 44% proficient and 38 MGP
 - **d.** Mr. King explained Blended Learning using technology and a Station Rotation Model and that some teachers are planning to try it next year.
