  - c) Furniture Grant This is being used for flexible seating. We have spent \$16,872 so far, \$8000 is left.
- 4. Current ideas, questions, needs, and/or concerns from Council and/or Community

   a) Required Training We watched the required training video for Community Council members
  - b) Election of officers
    - a. Natalie Argyle was nominated as the Community Council Chair by Nyla Weaver. Rebecca Mann seconded. All were in favor.
    - b. Rebecca Mann was nominated as the Vice Chair by Nyla Weaver. Alzina Barnhill seconded. All were in favor.
    - c. Nyla Weaver was nominated as the secretary. Rebecaa Mann seconded. All were in favor.
    - d. Nichole Burnham, prior to the meeting, proposed that we change our scheduled meetings to Tuesdays. Rebecca Mann seconded. All were in favor.

#### 5. Parent and Community Involvement

a) Recruitment of additional members - Our rules did not specify how many members were supposed to be on the council. Nyla Weaver proposed that we set the number of members required to a minimum of 4 members and 2 staff, and a maximum of 6 members and 3 staff. Rebecca Mann seconded and all were in favor.

### 6. Trust Lands Items, Budget, or Updates

- a) Update on Budget
- b) Review Goals
  - a. Last year's goals
    - i. Cook Elementary will improve mathematics proficiency by 5% from 45% in 2016-2017 to 50% in 2018-2019 by increasing time spent on blended learning opportunities for our students, including web-based mathematics programs. (SAGE & CRT)
    - ii. From Beginning of Year to Middle of Year, increase the percentage of K-6 students scoring at or above DIBELS/DAZE (middle-of-year composite score benchmark) by 5%.
    - iii. Provide a varied set of high-quality professional learning opportunities for staff depending on the school's needs.
  - B. This year's goals
    - i. Cook elementary will increase the number of students proficient on DIBELS composite by 12% from BOY to EOY.
    - ii. 80% of students across grades 1-4 will achieve automaticity in their math facts as measured by Reflex Math at the EOY. 80% of students 5-6 will achieve proficiency on Imagine Math benchmarks.
  - C. Voted on rollover money We ended up having \$4,161 carryover in addition to the \$1500 we had projected. Natalie Argyle proposed to use this carryover to purchase additional electronic devices to help us get to 1:1. Nyla seconded. Everyone was in favor.

- a) SEL The SEL TA is helping with Structured Recess Activities and also giving social and emotional support to some of the students who struggle at recess.
